ORDER

Gaswaga, J

Considering the application by David Boniface's (A2) counsel, Mr. Derjacques, for his release on bail it is hereby ordered that:-

- a) The accused be and is hereby re-admitted to bail.
- b) The accused should enter a bail bond in the sum of Rs. 20, 000/- with two sureties to be approved by the Court. Each surety will be bound in the sum of Rs.10, 000/-
- c) The accused should not leave the jurisdiction of Seychelles without an order of this Court.
- d) The accused should not interfere with the witnesses or the course of justice in this case in any way or get involved in any criminal activity.

- e) The accused should surrender his passport or any travel document issued to him to the Registrar of the Supreme Court before the release order is signed.
- f) The accused should report to the nearest police station being the Police Station every Monday, Wednesday and Friday before midday.
- g) If any of these conditions are breached this order for bail will be revoked and the accused will, unless a plausible explanation is offered, be remanded in custody.

The Registrar is to convey this order to the Director of Immigration and the Commissioner of Police.
